## 10. Other Sri Lanka Including, for The news on alleged sexual harassment was initially reported in print media in August 2023. Since this incident relates to example: workplace harassment, the Secretary General of Parliament took immediate measures to commence a preliminary investigation based on the allegations reported on those newspaper articles. Accordingly, a three-member committee Strategies to consisting of female high-ranking officials in Parliament of Sri Lanka was appointed to receive the complaints. **Overcome Gender Inequality** The above committee submitted a report and having gone through the findings of the report, the Parliament Secretariat Education unanimously decided that there's a prima facie element in this case.
